La Fraternidad Lodge No. 387 originally submitted its application to form a new lodge on April 16, 1855. It was granted dispensation to work under the Scottish Rite by the M∴W∴ Joseph D. Evans on June 11, 1855, making it the first lodge in the Northeast of the United States to expand the Masonic ideals and principals in the Spanish language. This lodge was established by six Cubans, one Colombian and one French, to wit: Andrés Cassard, Worshipful Master (Cuban); Francisco Párraga, Senior Warden (Colombian); Bernabé del Pozo, Junior Warden (Cuban); Gaspar de Artega, Chaplain (Cuban); Aníbal de Mosquera, Secretary (Cuban); Juan M. de la Cruz, Treasurer (Cuban); Enrique D'Espaigne, Senior Deacon (Cuban) and Juan Giglet, Junior Deacon (French). On the Annual Session of the Grand Lodge of New York on June 6, 1856, the Constitutive Letter or Charter was provided with the No. 387, therefore making "La Fraternidad No. 387".

The Masonic work done in the Tenth Manhattan District by La Fraternidad has been well celebrated and very productive, three lodges daughters have been instituted by members of this Worshipful Lodge: "La Universal No. 751"; "Abravanel No. 1116" and recently "Brazilian No. 1182". But the labor continued with the foundation of "Pan American No. 1124" by members of "La Universal Lodge" making this lodge directly a granddaughter of "La Fraternidad Lodge No. 387".

The most prominent member of this lodge will always be R: W: Andrés Cassard. He was born on Santiago de Cuba in 1823, was the son of European parents. At age 17, he entered the government in order to help his beloved country. Soon, he learned that in order to emerge he should get used to the slavery and oppression of the people, so he left the government and came to the United States on June, 1847. In 1853, he joined the lodge "Sincerite No. 2" which worked under the jurisdiction of the Supreme Council of New York Counsel. Then, he studied every single article and book available to him in order to create a lodge that would work on his native language. In 1854, he received the philosophical degrees of perfection, Counsel of princess of Jerusalem, Sir of the East and West and Sir of the Rosa Cruz. On May 17 of the same year, the Supreme Council of New York gave him the 33^{rd} Degree of the Scottish Rite.

Our lodge is and will always be: the common ground to work together, develop feelings of fraternal affection among our new members and develop our sentiments of Fraternity, Tolerance and Assistance. In other words, 'La Fraternidad' Lodge No.387 keeps alive the flame of "FRATERNITY".
