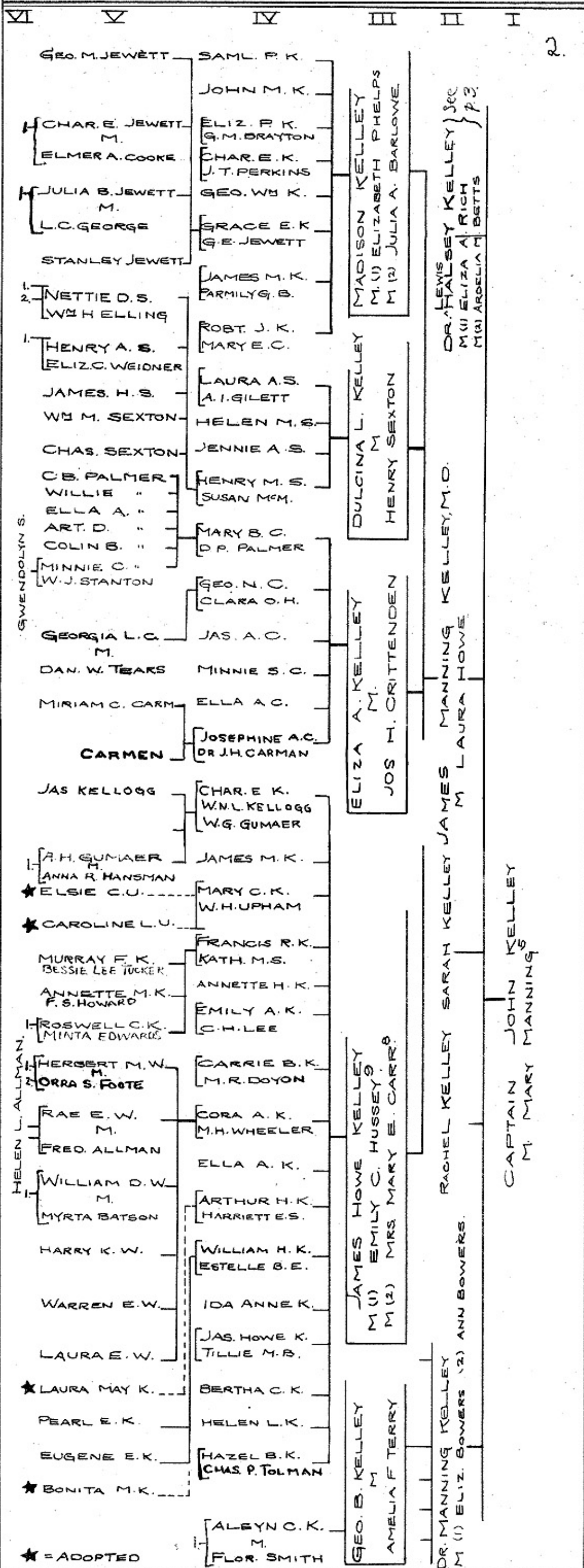

BORN IN VIRGINIA ABOUT 1760. SERVED TWO ENLISTMENTS 1777-1783 IN TROOPS OF VIRGINIA STATE MILITIA, REVOLUTIONARY WAR. THE FOLLOWING IS TAKEN FROM RECORDS OF STATE LIBRARY AND LAND OFFICE, RICHMOND, VA. :

" I DO HERE CERTIFIE THAT JOHN KELLEY HAVE SERVED THREE YEARS FROM THE 13TH OF JANY 1777 UNTIL 13 JANY 1780 AS A SOLDIER IN 2ND VIRGINIA STATE REG'T. GIVEN FROM UNDER MY HAND THIS 21ST FEBY 1783.

ON STATE ESTABLISHMENT "

AT THE CLOSE OF THE WAR, HE WENT NORTH, AND ELOPED WITH POLLY MANNING OF FREEHOLD, MONMOUTH CO., N. J., SETTLING AT BLACKBERRY HEDGE, SUMMERSET CO NEAR "WASHINGTON'S HEADQUARTERS." LATER THEY LIVED IN OVID, SENECA CO., N.Y. - ABOUT 18- TO 1810.

IN THE WAR OF 1812, HE RAISED AND EQUIPPED A COMPANY AND WON HIS TITLE. FROM U.S. WAR DEPT. :

SON OF CAPT. JOHN KELLEY + MARY [MANNING] KELLEY
 JAS. WAS BORN AT BLACKBERRY HEDGE, SUMMERSSET CO
 N.J. AUG. 1787. HIS MOTHER HAD MADE A RUNAWAY
 MATCH AND HAD BEEN DISINHERITED IN CONSEQUENCE.
 WHEN JAS. WAS A YOUNG BOY, HIS GRF MANNING SAW HIM,
 AND WAS GREATLY ATTRACTED BY HIS BEAUTY AND
 SPRIGHTLINESS - NOT KNOWING WHO JAS. WAS
 LATER JAS WAS ADOPTED BY HIS GRF MANNING, BROUGHT UP
 AS A GENTLEMAN + GIVEN EVERY ADVANTAGE - BEING SENT
 TO A PHILADELPHIA MEDICAL COLLEGE - WHERE HIS SPRUCENESS
 IN DRESS GAINED HIM THE SOBRIQUET OF "THE RUFFLE SHIRT
 DOCTOR" WITH HIS LARGE BLUE EYES, LONG LASHES, CURLING LOCKS
 AND GENERAL AIR OF CULTURE, HE MUST HAVE PRESENTED A
 VERY HANDSOME + ATTRACTIVE APPEARANCE. UPON COMING OF AGE
 JAS STOLE AWAY TO VISIT HIS MOTHER - AND WAS PROMPTLY
 CAST OFF BY HIS GRF - WHO HAD NEVER FORGIVEN HER.
 JAS. WAS MARRIED IN 1807-8 IN TO OVID N.Y. TO LAURA HOWE
 INT. CRITTENDON LOT, ERIE STREET CEMETERY, CLEVELAND, OHIO

[DAU. OF SAM. + MABEL (DUDLEY) HOWE]. HIS WAR. RECORD :
 "IT IS SHOWN BY THE OFFICIAL RECORDS THAT JAMES M. KELLY
 WAS APPOINTED SURGEON'S MATE, 42d UNITED STATES INFANTRY,
 AUG. 4, 1813; THAT HE ACCEPTED THE APPOINTMENT AUG. 25, 1813,
 FROM WARREN, OHIO, AND THAT HE RESIGNED SEPTEMBER 15, 1814.
 WHILE IN THE SERVICE, HE WAS STATIONED AT THOMPSON'S
 FORT, STATEN ISLAND, BUT HIS HEALTH GAVE OUT AND
 HE DIED OF CONSUMPTION AT PITTSFORD, N.Y. JULY 31, 1815.

DR. HOWE WAS BORN IN LONGMEADOW CT., IN 1760, DIED IN PAINESVILLE, OHIO IN 1838. HE WAS OF ENGLISH DESCENT, + WAS BROUGHT UP BY HIS STEPFATHER AND TREATED VERY KINDLY. AFTER RECEIVING A COMMON SCHOOL EDUCATION, HE ENTERED THE COLLEGE OF DARTMOUTH, AT THE AGE OF 19, AND DURING THE ENSUING YEAR MADE SOME PROFICIENCY IN THE STUDY OF MEDICINE.

THE NEXT YEAR (17⁷⁹/₈₀), BEING IN BOSTON ONE DAY, HE SHIPPED AS SURGEON ON BOARD AN AMERICAN PRIVATEER, THEN FITTING OUT FOR A CRUISE ALONG THE COAST. CONTRARY TO THE UNDERSTANDING OF THE CREW THE CRAFT WAS STEERED DIRECT FOR THE ENGLISH CHANNEL, THE SHIP PROVING A MISERABLE THING, LEAKING BADLY, TWO MEN WERE KEPT CONSTANTLY AT THE PUMPS FOR FORTY DAYS, - THE CAPTAIN BEING IN A STATE OF INTOXICATION NEARLY THE ENTIRE TIME. ONE DARK NIGHT THEY FOUND THEMSELVES ALONGSIDE A BRITISH 74 ON THE COAST OF IRELAND. THE PRIVATEER FIRED ONE GUN AND SURRENDERED SOON AFTER THE CREW WERE REMOVED TO THE 74 THE OLD HULK WENT DOWN, TO THEIR GREAT JOY, NOT BEING WORTH TOWING INTO PORT.

THEY WERE CARRIED INTO DUBLIN AS PRISONERS OF WAR, WHERE DR. HOWE WAS DETAILED IN THE MEDICAL DEPT. OF DUBLIN PRISON, THEN FILLED WITH SICK AND MAIMED PRISONERS. AFTER NEARLY THREE YEARS, HOWE AND TWO OTHER DOCTORS, BRIBED CRAFT, AN IRISHMAN, KEEPER OF THE PRISON, - AND ESCAPED TO FRANCE. HERE HE WALKED 300 MILES TO THE PORT OF HAVRE AND SHIPPED AS A HAND BEFORE THE MAST FOR BOSTON. YEARS LATER CRAFT CAME TO PAINESVILLE, AND HE + DR. HOWE MET + RECOGNIZED EACH OTHER.

AFTER HIS RETURN, HOWE COMPLETED HIS MEDICAL STUDIES, AND ABOUT 1785, MARRIED MABEL DUDLEY^F OF MIDDLETOWN, CONN. THEY LIVED FOR A TIME IN CLIFTON PARK, N.Y. AND LATER IN OVID, N.Y. IN 1811 DR. HOWE SETTLED IN CANADA, NEAR QUEENSTOWN, 8 MILES FROM NIAGARA FALLS. DR. HOWE HAD ACCUMULATED LARGE POSSESSIONS; HAVING 200 HEAD OF CATTLE, HORSES, 500 ACRES OF THE FINEST LAND, A BEAUTIFUL ENGLISH MANSION, -^{ES} AN IRON BOX FILLED WITH GOLD COIN, AND GOOD SECURITI-
WORTH \$60,000.

AT THE BREAKING OUT OF THE WAR OF 1812, HE WAS SUMMONED TO DECLARE FOR THE KING - OR TO LEAVE THE PROVINCE IN AN HOUR AND HAVE HIS PROPERTY CONFISCATED. BREAKFAST WAS ON THE TABLE - INDIANS EVERYWHERE; BUT HE DAMNED THE KING AND DECLARED FOR THE STATES. HIS WIFE + DAU. HARRIET PACKED THE BEST BEDDING, SILVER, + BOX OF GOLD AND THE DR. PUT THEM ON A SCOW + STARTED THEM ACROSS THE RIVER TO THE STATES. WHEN A FEW FEET FROM SHORE THE SCOW SANK, THE INDIANS HAVING BEEN HIRED TO BORE HOLES IN THE BOTTOM - AND THE WOMEN BARELY ESCAPED. A BRITISH OFFICER, HARRIET'S FIANCEE, SAVED THEM FROM THE INDIANS - HE WAS LATER KILLED AT LUNDY'S LANE.

IN THE MEANTIME, DR. HOWE WENT BACK TO THE HOUSE, PURPOSING TO THROW HIS STRONG BOX INTO THE RIVER, RATHER THAN AID THE BRITISH. HE FOUND THE HOUSE IN FLAMES; BUT SECURED A FEATHER BED, TIED IT UPON HIS MARE KATE + RODE FOR THE UPPER FERRY - AMID A SHOWER OF BULLETS WHICH RIDDLED THE BED + PUT OUT ONE OF KATE'S EYES. HIS SONS MET HIM AT THE FERRY - AND IN CROSSING - A BALL PIERCED THE TOP OF WILLIAM'S HIGH BELL CROWNED HAT.

THE FAMILY FOUND A NEW HOME NEAR LEWISTOWN, + WHEN THE BRITISH TOOK THAT PLACE, DEC. 18, 1813; THE HOWES AGAIN ESCAPED - ON A SLED DRAWN BY OXEN TO BATAVIA, N.Y. HERE WAS ORGANIZED SWIFT + DOBBINS' REGT. OF NEW YORK VOLTS, WITH DR. HOWE AS SURGEON'S MATE. HE WAS ACCOMPANIED BY HIS SONS, DUDLEY + ASAHEL, TOOK PART IN GEN. SCOTT'S CAMPAIGN, INCLUDING BATTLE OF LUNDY'S LANE - + SERVED MAY 1, 1814 - NOV. 8, 1814.

IN 1817 HE WENT TO CLEVELAND, O., AND ABOUT 1820 TO PAINESVILLE, O. - WHERE HE PRACTICED HIS PROFESSION UNTIL HIS DEATH IN 1838.

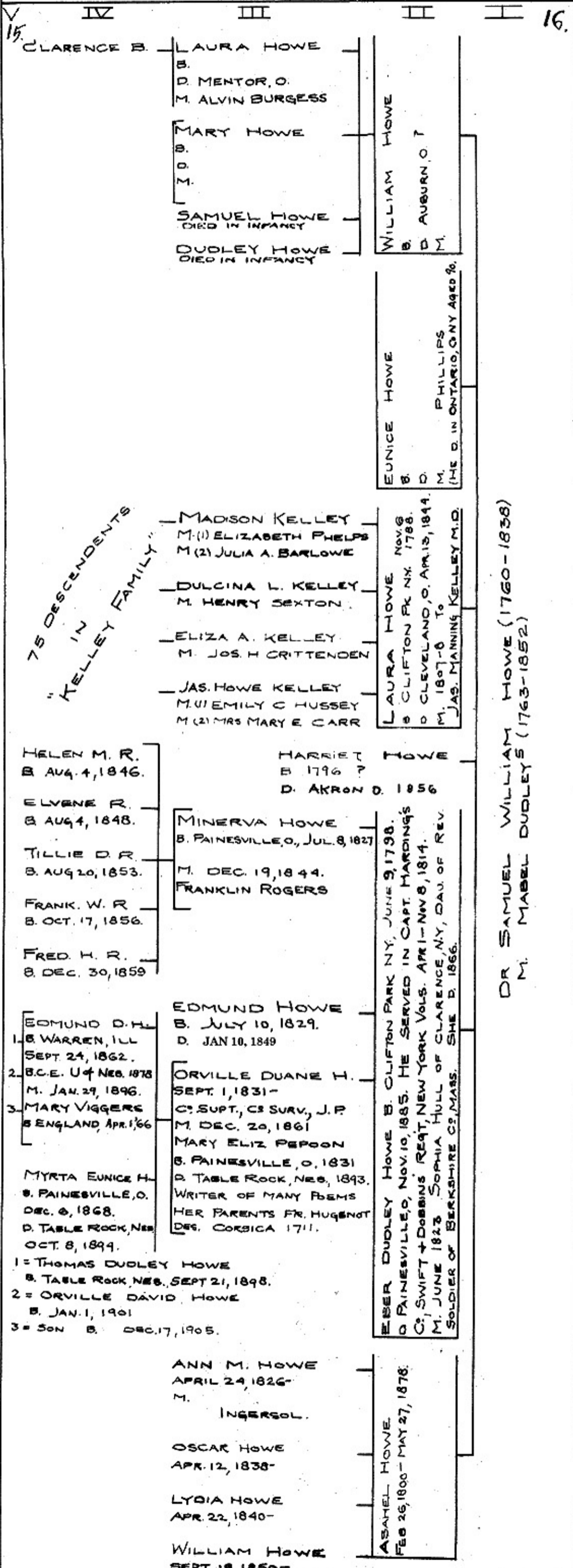
