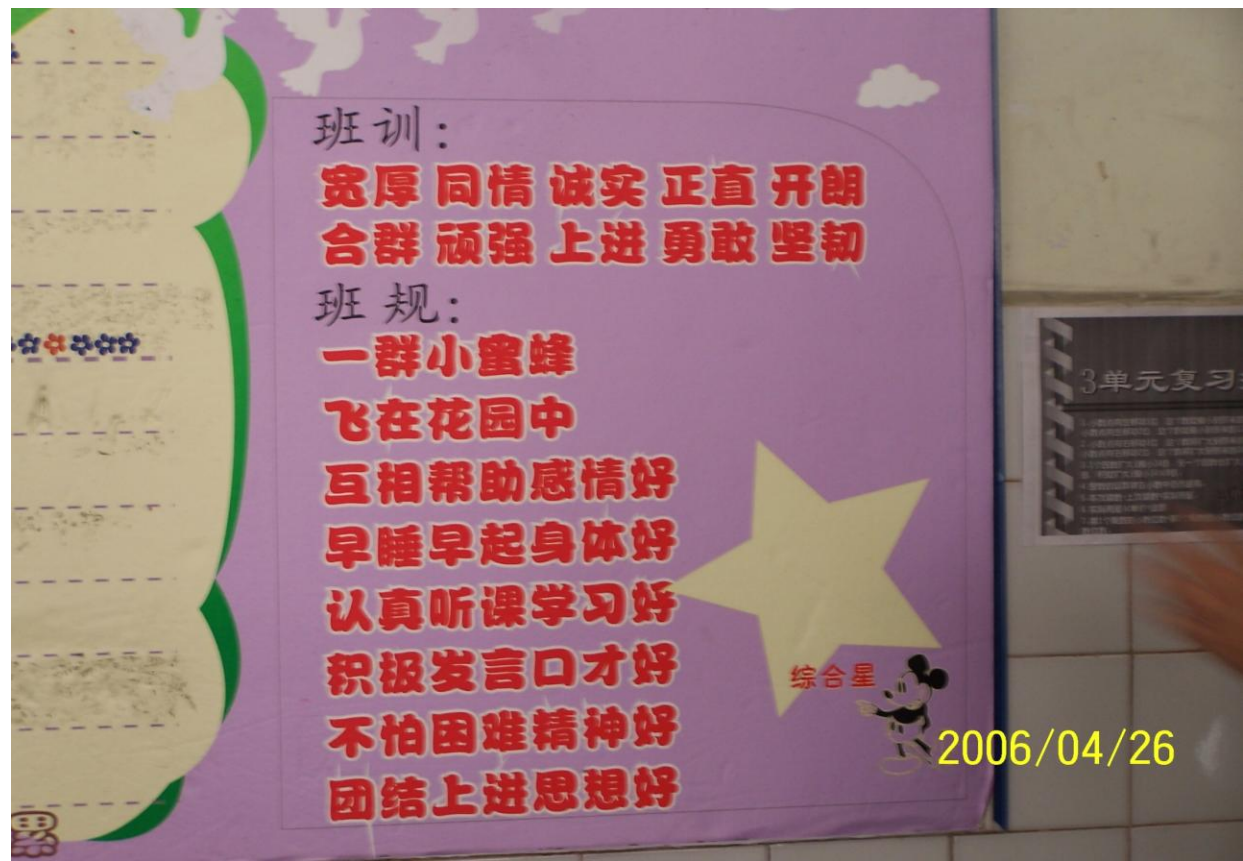

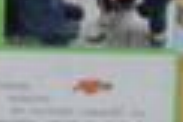

Higher Education

- College Entrance Examination (Gao Kao) is national. Similar to SAT in a sense.
- Terms of study. Colleges and universities – usually 4 years; master's degree – 2-3 years, and doctor's degree – 3-4 years
- Almost all institutions provide food and boarding for students on campus, and consequently a typical student enrolled in a university live in a dormitory room which she/he share with from 1 to 7 people, and eat in the dining halls on campus.
- Students take more classes than in other countries like the U.S., it is not rare that an undergraduate in China take 7 or 8 classes a semester.
- Higher education institutions start to charge tuition in 1986 after abolishing the tax-supported ed system. College applicants are encouraged to compete for merit-based scholarship. There are also need-based loans for students who are financially challenged.
- There were about 4000 institutions, 16 million students and the gross enrollment rate was 15% (in the year 2005).
- The expansion of higher education institutions in the last 15 years results in a surplus of college graduates, who face unemployment.
