

### Grading Rubrics for Chapter 2's Timeline

Creating Timeline (2)	Your timeline follows the required format and accurately records more than <b><u>eight major events</u></b> that are relevant to the topic of slavery. Your timeline has no grammatical or spelling errors.	Your timeline follows the required format. However, the timeline does not accurately record all the major events that are relevant to the topic of slavery. You selected eight major events as the minimum requirement. Your timeline has more than three spelling errors.	Your timeline does not follow the required format. The timeline has recorded inappropriate events that are not relevant to the topic of slavery. The events you listed are fewer than the required eight. Your timeline has more than six spelling errors.
Reflecting on (2) Timeline	You ask <b><u>at least three questions</u></b> for students to answer using the timeline you created. Your students will be encouraged to use the timeline you created and other information in this chapter to answer <u>all</u> the questions you asked. Your responses to the two given questions are thoughtful and written in complete sentences. Your reflections are written in complete sentences and have no spelling and/or grammatical errors.	You ask at least three questions for students to answer using the timeline you created. Your students will not be able to use the timeline you created and the information in this chapter to answer these questions you asked. Your responses to the two questions are somewhat thoughtful, and they are written in complete sentences. Your reflections have more than three spelling and/or grammatical errors.	You ask less than three questions. Or you do ask three questions, but one of them or more than one of them is not related to the topic of slavery. Students will not be able to use your timeline you created and the information in this chapter to answer all the questions you asked. Your responses to the two questions are not specific or thoughtful. Your reflections are not written in complete sentences and have more than six grammatical and/or spelling errors.
