It sounds like other cases are not serious. I really want to help Monica Long, also known as Monica Oaks (fadetoblack_24@yahoo.com). She is a non-traditional student juggling very successfully and masterfully with children, work, and study. She will take three courses this summer, and take a full load in the fall in Block II. However, some courses conflict with her work.

I attach her CAPP to show you that she took ATS 102 prior to coming to Cortland. On her CAPP, ATS is counted as Additional HUM.

For GE07, she has transferred Credits.

Can we let GE07, the transferred credit count as her HUM Concentration's Additional HUMGE07 category, and let ATS 102 count as her ART category in Concentration?

That will save her an invaluable space (and money for a 3-credit) course.
