The Reflection Essay on Professional Dispositions

Explanation

I believe you have reviewed and discussed a two-page "SUNY Cortland Childhood/Early Childhood Education Department Assessment of Candidates' Professional Dispositions" document in class during Block I and with instructors in Block II. In this course, you are going to write a short essay of 2 to 3 pages (12 font size, single-spaced, with margins set at 1 inch at all sides) to reflect upon your understanding of the professional dispositions required of all teacher candidates in the Department of Childhood and Early Childhood Education. You will describe your performance while you take courses on campus and during your field placement/experiences. Your reflection essay should follow APA Style and be free of grammatical and spelling errors. Please go to ASAP on campus to seek editorial assistance if it is necessary.

If you need to refresh your memory about the professional dispositions required for all candidates in our department, please read the attached two-page Professional Dispositions before you draft your essay.

The following questions will help you reflect and describe how you perform during practicum and while you take courses on campus.

- 1) What are some of the areas, if any, that you believe you have demonstrated <u>excellent</u> professional dispositions? Please use specific examples in three major areas of your choice as evidence to support your statements.
- 2) What are some of the areas, if any, that you believe you have demonstrated <u>satisfactory</u> professional dispositions? Please use specific examples in three major areas of your choice as evidence to support your statements.
- 3) What are the some of the areas, if any, that you believe you have <u>not demonstrated</u> satisfactory professional dispositions? Please use specific examples in three major areas of your choice as evidence to support your statements. Please describe how you are going to improve your performances in these areas during student teaching.

If you need help to submit assignments on eLearning/WebCt, please feel free to ask the instructor. Your essay should not have more than 3 grammatical and spelling errors.
